

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF RECLAMATION DISTRICT NO. 1600

Tuesday, August 8, 2023
Bypass Farms, 14130 County Road 117, West Sacramento, CA

Trustees attending: Michele Clark, Ammy Reyes, Rebecca Yeung

Others attending: Rebecca Smith (District Counsel), Tina Anderson (MBK Engineers)

Call to Order: Clark called the meeting to order at 3:10 pm with all trustees in attendance.

- 1. Report by Tina Anderson of MBK Engineers on Maintenance and Related Matters
 - a. Flood System Repair Program (FSRP) Anderson reports that it will be funded before winter
 - b. Vegetation & Rodent Control Work underway, including burning the levee using Elkhorn Volunteer Fire crew
 - c. DWR Road Repair Anderson and Reyes meeting next week
 - d. FEMA Claim Anderson reports this is ongoing
 - e. Repair of 75 hp Pump and Related Pump Issues <u>Clark reports that insurance</u> <u>claim was successful, and District received partial payment for the work</u> from Glatfelter.

Motion by Reyes, second by Yeung authorizing signing of contract to repair or rebuild the 75hp pump motor not to exceed \$50,000. Motion by Reyes, second by Yeung authorizing signing of contract to install 75hp pump motor not to exceed \$25,000.

Yeung to reach out to potential contractors; Anderson to work on bid for work.

- f. Deferred Maintenance Program Anderson is in contact with DWR to apply for funds from DWR's Deferred Maintenance Program to fix the gravity drain.
- g. Other On-Going Maintenance Matters <u>Smith recommends the District</u> <u>establish a maintenance of ditches plan. Will add to September agenda.</u>

Anderson left the meeting.
